Involve young people in meaningful ways in finding solutions and in decision-making processes that have an impact on our shared future. It is possible and necessary to do more than we do today.









RESOURCE GROUP ON ENVIRONMENT - WORLD YMCA OFFICE GENEVA 2015-2016





Increase the presence and influence of young people in international decision-making on climate change related issues; advocate for increased environmental education and its funding; and to present youth organisations as partners of choice to implement programmes in this area.

ACTION 1 - Guarantee youth presence within relevant international forums such as the UNFCCC, Green Climate Fund, ECOSOC and others.

ACTION 2 - Ensure consistent inclusion in decision and outcome documents of:

- The need for environmental education
- Partnerships with youth organisations
- The need for increased funding for environmental education
- Participation of civil society in decision-making





Provide Learning opportunities around environmental issues, in order to develop and mobilise young leaders for initiatives reducing environmental degradation and promoting sustainable development.

ACTION 1- Develop and deliver an online training programme for leadership on climate change issues reaching 1.000 young people from at least 50 countries by the end of 2016.

ACTION 2 - Select one environment project to offer to YMCAs worldwide along with dedicated consulting by the end of 2016.
